## **Department 7A Cattle – Youth**

## Please review "Exhibit Information - General Rules and Information." See "Main Menu -Calendar" for entry schedule.

1. General information for all Junior Cattle entries:

A. Entry forms must be completed on each animal and returned by date posted in Calendar to the County Extension Office or uploaded on the Fair website.

B. All beef cattle that are purebred must have registration papers at the time of entry.

C. Entries are open to 4-H or FHA members, 9-18 years of age that are from Cullman or bordering counties and not more than one year out of High School

D. No heifers in barn until day of show.

E. Where there is no competition in a class, second prize money will be given.

F. Animals will be classed by age and by registration papers. Each entry must have registration papers at time of entry and be in the name of the exhibitor except in a commercial division.

G. To be eligible to compete for premiums, all animals must be halter broken and well groomed.

H. No more than two (2) entries may be made in one class by the same exhibitor.

- I. Feed and care must be furnished by the exhibitor.
- J. Health Regulations:

1. General: All cattle exhibited must appear in healthy condition. An official health certificate signed by an accredited veterinarian is not required

- 2. Brucellosis Regulations:
  - A. No test required on calves under 6 months of age.
  - B. No test required on officially calf hood vaccinated animals under 24 months.

C. No test required on Alabama cattle if they originate from a herd that is not under quarantine because of brucellosis.

D. Tuberculosis Requirements: No TB test required

2. Junior Cattle Judging:

A. Contest limited to 4-H, FCCLA, and FFA teams.

- B. Each club is eligible to enter 1 team, consisting of 4 members.
- C. The scores of the 3 highest scoring individuals will constitute the team score.
- D. 10 minutes will be allowed for scoring each class.
- E. Both team and individual awards will be awarded:
  - 1. Team Awards: 1st \$30 2nd \$25 3rd \$20 4th \$15 5th \$10
  - 2. Individual Awards: 1st \$15 2nd \$10 3rd \$5

3. Junior Dairy Cattle:

A. Contestants must own one or more dairy animals entered in the Fair; each contestant must show his or her own animal(s).

B. Ages of show persons are as of January 1st the year of the Fair.

C. Ayrshire, Guernsey, Jersey, Brown Swiss, Holstein, and Commercial breeds allowed.

D. All breeds will compete against each other.

D. Awards: 1st - \$65 2nd - \$55 3rd - \$45 4th - \$35 5th - \$25 All others - \$15

E. Rosettes will be awarded to the Grand and Reserve Champions

4. Junior Beef Showmanship:

A. Contestants must own one or more beef animals entered in the Fair; each contestant must show his or her own animal(s).

B. Ages of show persons are as of January 1st the year of the Fair.

C. Animals will be shown clean and dry with tail down and nothing on the hair coat.

D. Trophies provided by the Cullman County Cattlemen's Association will be awarded for 1st through 3rd place; no cash awards.

E. A special trophy will be awarded to the Best Girl Steer Show person by the Cullman County Cattlewoman's Association; no cash award.

5. Junior Feeder Steer Show:

A. All breeds will compete against one another.

B. Steers will be divided into a maximum of eight (8) classes.

C. The 1st and 2nd place winners from each class will return to the ring after the completion

of all the classes for the selection of the Grand Champion and Reserve Grand Champion.

D. Steers will be released at the completion of the show.

E. Awards: 1st - \$65 2nd - \$55 3rd - \$45 4th - \$35 5th - \$25 All others - \$15

F. Rosettes will be awarded to the Grand and Reserve Champions

6. Junior Heifer Show:

A. Females may be separated into 6 classes based on age

B. Class 01 will be for those born in the year of the Fair

C. Class 06 will be for 2 years old females born in the fall 2 years before the Fair year

D. Awards: 1st - \$65 2nd - \$55 3d - \$45 4th - \$35 5th - \$25 5 All Others - \$15

E. Rosettes: Rosettes will be awarded to the Grand and Reserve Champions
