

## Department 1 Field and Garden Crops and Honey – Open & Youth R-1

**Please review "Exhibit Information - General Rules and Information." See "Calendar" for entry schedule.**

1. All exhibits must be cleaned by the exhibitor before arriving for display in the quantity stated for each category. Do not bring excessive quantities.
2. Please do not request Fair staff assist in determining which produce you wish to display.
3. The Fair will provide baskets and other display aids which are the property of the Fair. Baskets and display aids provided will be retained for reuse the next year by the Fair.
4. Entries must be produced by entrant or their family. You may enter as many classes as you wish, however, only one entry per entrant per class.
5. All exhibits must remain in place in the Agricultural Exhibit Building until 9:00 AM Sunday, immediately following the last day of the Fair. All exhibits shall be picked up by 5:00 PM on that Sunday; exhibits not picked up by that time will be disposed of by the Fair staff.
6. Please ensure Honey division entries are not pre-labeled with your name or farm on the container. Pre-labeled entries cannot be accepted.
7. Giant vegetable entries are not eligible to be judged in the regular produce divisions and will be judged separately. The following special criteria apply:
  - a. Foliage should be included only where it forms an integral part of the specimen; no surplus water is allowed.
  - b. Foliage must not be included in the weight or length of any vegetable (other than above) and must be cleanly removed from the base of all leaf systems.
  - c. Onion leaves must be trimmed to the first leaf joint.
  - d. Sticks, stones, soil or any substance that is not plant matter of the specimen must not be included in the weight or length of the entry.
  - e. Pumpkins, squash and zucchini stalks must not be more than 3" in length.
  - f. Watermelon, tomato and cucumber stalks must not be more than 1" in length.
  - g. See table for minimum entry criteria.
  - h. There will be only one (1) award winner per class. Awards vary by vegetable, see below.
8. Any produce which rots or decomposes will be removed from the display area and properly disposed. Disposed product ribbons earned will be retained by the Fair staff for the exhibitor and may be picked up at the Fair Office.
9. Check that your exhibit item is listed below. We regret that no exhibits can be accepted that are not listed below. If you would like an item added, we can discuss it for the next Fair year.
10. Open Awards: 1st \$15 2nd \$12 3rd \$10 Giant Vegetable Awards: Pumpkin, watermelon, tomato, squash and zucchini: 1st \$100 Giant Vegetable Awards: Sweet potato, Irish potato, onion, carrot and cucumber: 1st \$50 Child Special Submission Award: Ribbon Only.
