## Department 3 Baked Foods - Open

## Please review "Exhibit Information - General Rules and Information." See "Main Menu Calendar" for entry schedule.

1. Judging will be based on Appearance 25\%, Taste and Texture 75\%.
2. All exhibits must be entered on disposable plates and placed in plastic zip-lock bags. Pies should be baked in disposable aluminum pie tins and placed in zip-lock bags or covered with plastic wrap. Cakes must be entered on heavy cardboard covered with foil 1 inch larger than the cake and covered with plastic wrap.
3. Exhibitor will be required to bring $1 / 2$ cake to be judged, except for decorated cakes, and this cake will remain for the Fair.
4. Decorated cakes will be judged on decoration only; dummy bases may be used.
5. Standard size $1 / 2$ pie or 3 tart pie tins will be required.
6. Exhibitor will be required to bring $1 \not 12$ loaf of bread or one mini-loaf.
7. Cookies, brownies and candies are 1 dozen (12) on a plate.
8. $1 / 2$ dozen (6) biscuits and muffins.
9. A professional is defined as anyone who has sold bakery items for a period of more than 1 year.
10. The Fair has the option to discard food as it spoils.
11. Exhibitors shall submit recipes with each entry.
12. All entries become the property of Cullman County Fair Association.
13. One entry per person in each class.
14. No purchased items are eligible.
15. "King/Queen of the Kitchen" rules:
A. Entrant must declare they are competing for the King/Queen of the Kitchen, Division 7, below when entering items. This is now a paid event, award values listed below.
B. Only entries in the 6 Baked Food "Open" divisions and their classes will be considered. Senior and youth entries will not be considered within the competition.
C. Entrant must enter at least ten items. There are six divisions each with varying numbers of classes. At least one item must be submitted in the class of your choice within each of the 6 divisions. An additional four items must be submitted in any other divisions and classes of your
choice. If the entrant enters more than ten items, only the top ten scoring entries will be scored but this scoring shall include at least one class entry for each division. If an entry is in a class with no competition, it will be scored as a second-place entry even if it received a blue ribbon. This is consistent with Fair rules across all categories of competition.
D. Class placing scoring points: 1st-3 points 2nd-2 points 3rd-1 point.
E. A certificate and check will be awarded, and the winner will be announced to the local press with a photo opportunity while the Fair is ongoing.
F. All past winners of the King/Queen of the Kitchen are eligible since this a paid event.
