1. Junior Pet Show:

- A. Entry forms must be completed on each animal and returned by date posted in Calendar to the County Extension Office or uploaded on the Fair website.
- B. Participants must be no younger than age 9 and no older than age 18.
- C. Pets must be owned by the exhibitor or immediate family.
- D. Dogs must be 6 months old or older.
- E. Participants must pre-register and provide proof of rabies vaccinations for cats and dogs within the past 12 months.
- F. Pets must be on a leash and under the control of the exhibitor at all times. Birds will kept in cages.
- G. Dogs will show last and will be put in the goat pens until their time to show.
- H. Pets that are aggressive, out of control, or attempting to bite will be removed from the show and must leave the Fairgrounds.
- I. Maximum of 1 dog and 1 other pet may be shown per exhibitor.
- J. No wildlife or livestock, poultry or other commercial fowl allowed.
